Applications are hereby invited from suitably qualified candidates for the position of Chief Security Officer in the College.

THE COLLEGE

The Federal College of Education (Special), Oyo is owned by the Federal Government of Nigeria. It was established in 1977 with the mandate of producing specialized teachers at the NCE level who upon graduation will be ingrained with skills and competences that will enable them teach both “normal” and persons with special needs in the primary school as well as the lower level of secondary education.

The College has grown over the years and presently has very large number of student population of diverse cultural background, orientation and exposure. In addition, it also has an increasing population of Degree students undergoing studies along with the NCE students within the same campus.

The College is situated on a very large expanse of land dotted with physical structures, equipment and facilities, with developed link roads in most part, requiring adequate protection.

THE JOB

- i) The Chief Security Officer shall be directly responsible to the Provost and Chief Executive Officer of the College.
- ii) Shall exercise overall control of all security personnel in the College.
- iii) Shall advise the Provost in the prevention and diffusion of security challenges/issues in the College.
- iv) Shall evolve a security framework that would at least be susceptible to troublemakers.
- v) Shall maintain and sustain result-oriented and positive working relationship with the security agents operating around the host communities of the College as well as other significant stakeholders as to ensure the security interest of the College.

THE PERSON

Candidates for the position shall be:

- i) A retired Police Officer not below the rank of ASP or equivalent rank in the Security Services who must have spent at least eight years on the rank before retirement.
- ii) Graduates with professional training and cognate experience of at least eight years in security matters.

- iii) Must possess demonstrable skills in intelligence gathering and effective crowd control.
- iv) For (i) and (ii) above, previous experience in security management in tertiary educational institution shall be an added advantage.
- v) Must not be below fifty-five years of age.
- vi) The successful candidate shall be expected to assume duty within two weeks of appointment.
